SAFETY

Your safety, welfare and well-being is really important to us. We have procedures in place to help you feel safe, secure, and respected in our service.



CONCERNS

If you are worried or concerned or are being harmed by someone, tell someone you trust. It is never okay for someone to harm you and it is not your fault.



CONFIDENTIALITY

We respect your privacy and are committed to keeping your information safe. If you or we are concerned about your safety, we need to talk with TUSLA and/or An Garda Síochána. Your information will be treated with respect and shared only on a "need-to-know" basis.
